



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

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Cracks in the integrity of one of our country's most cherished institutions

Both teams were in a tight pennant race along with the Philadelphia Athletics and the Boston Red Sox. It was a day of firsts — first train ride, first trip to a city bigger than Buffalo, and the first and only time I saw Bob Feller, Satchel Paige, Lou Boudreau, Larry Doby, Joe DiMaggio, Yogi Berra and Phil Rizzuto.

And now, the Dodgers have adopted the Yankees' pecuniary habits, spending money on players like drunken mem-

dium down by the waterfront, with nearly 80,000 fans packing the venue. During the first game, a Cleveland player did something grand, and I leapt to my feet cheering. My father and two brothers, all diehard Yankee fans, were stunned. They had assumed I shared their allegiance. But it was the Indians who swept both games, and at least one of us enjoyed the quiet train ride home. To me, the Yankees were the embodiment of an evil

empire, spilling cash like the Exxon Valdez spilled oil. They could use their deep pockets to lure top talent, including Roger Maris, Reggie Jackson, Gerrit Cole, Catfish Hunter, Roger Clemens, Juan Soto — all the way back to Babe Ruth. The Babe transformed the Yankees from an average team into a powerhouse and helped establish their dynasty. Their financial clout, then and now, tilted the playing field.

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

an official sports betting partner. Such an alliance doesn't exactly inspire confidence in the game's integrity. I can only imagine Pete Rose trying to slug his way out of his grave over that union of convenience.

Despite my dislike for the Yankees, I admire their adherence to an "appearance rule" that prohibits long hair, unkempt beards and excessive jewelry. In contrast, some Dodgers looked as if they just came from a bling-fest at Tiffany's. To me, that tells the fans, "I'm making millions a year and you're not."

This year, I mostly watched the games with the sound off. Two broadcasters in the booth is one too many. Three is an insult to listeners. They spew commentary because silence risks their jobs. Everything is over-analyzed. I don't care if the pitcher threw a two-seam fastball with cut, or a

four-seamer with sink. I wouldn't know the difference, anyway. Keep it as simple as the game itself — a guy throws a ball, another guy hits it or misses it. Case closed.

The best broadcasters never played the game professionally, sparing us of the need to impress us with their "insider" jargon. Where are you, Vin Scully, when we need you?

Now cameras mounted on umpire helmets offer a fisheye view as if I were watching the game with a school of sardines. Television should give viewers the best seat in the house, not one they wouldn't take for free.

And yet, despite all of this, I'll still follow the Hot-Stove League news about trades, hoping my Giants pick up a power-hitting first baseman, a slugging outfielder, and another starting pitcher — or two. After all, opening day is only about four months away.
