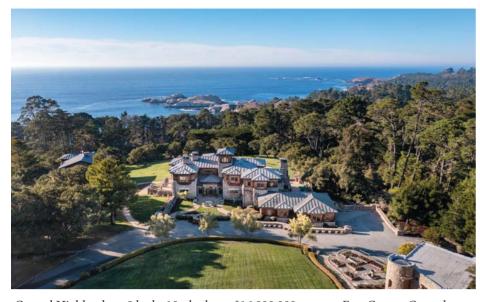

OW CLOSE is 1494 Cypress Drive to the Lodge at Pebble Beach? Well, the navigator on my phone took me to the Lodge and abandoned me there with a perfunctory, "Arrived." After a quick call to realtor Nic Canning of Sotheby's Canning Properties Group and less than one more minute in the car, however, all was well.

"Gem Cove" is a six-bedroom fairytale Tudor Revival home that looks like it's right out of "Beauty and the Beast." Think exterior beams and stone chimneys, with a roof that includes slate reclaimed from an old chateau, Canning said. He has the listing at \$57.5 million.

Restraint

Designed by International Design Group, or IDG, in Pacific Grove, the house was built in 2003. Although it sits on two

lots with about 2.14 acres of land and has more than 11,000 square feet of living area, it doesn't sprawl. It's politely restrained, with spaces that are convivial and inviting, and scattered spots for intimate conversations.

Clearly the home was designed with entertaining in mind. A gently sloping driveway leads from the gate to the front door and the three-car garage. Beyond the house are waves and rocks, with sweeping views of Point Lobos, Carmel Point, the 18th Fairway – basically a private highlight reel of the best of the Peninsula.

The main entry is through a generous foyer, beyond which lies the living room and dining area, with plenty of windows on the scenic panorama, plus an elegantly understated fireplace. Throughout the main floor are high ceilings with open beams.

Off to the left is a 28-by-29-foot rec room with a built-in wooden bar that seats three people comfortably and gives the mixologist plenty of room to work. Builtin shelves offer room for favorite bottles and a nice spot to show off photos, golf trophies or some Concours award ribbons.

Culinary playground

Behind the bar is a main-floor bedroom with an en suite bath, complete with Jack-and-Jill sinks. Doors open onto the back patio, which runs nearly the length of the house.

To the right of the living room are the kitchen and the breakfast nook. While it's a home cook's playground, that kitchen would easily accommodate a chef and catering crew with one continuous 20-orso-foot plateau of counter space paralleling a huge center island, where guests can have a snack and watch the culinary magic

Preserving memories from the days before iPhones and YouTube

ACCORDING TO the breakdown of generations, I am part of the "silent generation," born between 1928 and 1945. Which is ironic, because we won't shut up about how things used to be. Coupled with baby boomers (1946-1964), we might be the last two generations to remember life before computers — back when "going viral" meant

you were in for some ugly symptoms, not fame on TikTok. The responsibility of preserving our memories of the great events of the 20th century feels like a burden, mainly because I'm fairly certain Gen Z thinks World War II was a

In 1988, President George H.W. Bush was ridiculed for

calling for a "kinder, gentler nation." Critics treated it like he'd suggested we all start wearing cardigans and baking cookies. The ridicule was considered an extension of the "wimp factor" that followed Bush around like a persistent telemarketer. Never mind that he served as a Navy aviator and was a genuine war hero, the kindness he called for later in life wasn't macho enough for the Oval Office.

Yet, that's exactly what I remember. Kindness, manners, respect, honor, faith, duty and sacrifice were not just ideals we aspired to — they were the minimum standard, and failing at them meant you'd hear about it at church, school, and definitely at home.

But here's the thing — that was how we actually lived. Those of us who lived through World War II remember it as the last war where everyone back home was doing

something. Adults genuinely worried we might lose. Imagine that level of engagement now. "Sorry, can't storm the beaches, got a Netflix series to finish."

Compare that to Korea, Vietnam, Iraq, Afghanistan life went on like normal unless you knew someone over there. But between 1939 and 1945, war bonds, scrap drives, rationing, blackouts, air raid drills, the entire economy retooled for tanks instead of Buicks. Everyone from kindergarteners to Grandma was involved. Real sacrifice, not the kind where you change your profile picture and go back to your latte.

Speed vs. progress

Life before computers gets romanticized as a time of handwritten letters and friendly telephone operators. In reality, it meant you couldn't avoid people — not your neighbors, not your responsibilities, not uncomfortable conversations.

Look, I'm not saying the old days were perfect. They absolutely weren't. But somewhere between butter churning and bitcoin, we confused speed with progress and convenience with connection. We have instant access to all human knowledge and mostly use it to confirm what we

IN YOUR DREAMS

THAT'S A MIGHTY BIG HOUSEPLANT YOU'VE GOT THERE

REES AND houses don't just live side-by-side in Carmel-by-the-Sea. They cohabit like a bunch of hippies. This story was supposed to start with a brief anecdote from the archives about how much locals have always loved their pines, cypresses and oaks, but that backfired when a search for "tree" brought up virtually every issue in the paper's 100-plus-year run. After all, it is The Pine Cone.

There was, however, an item in November 1951 about a home with "two wings bisected by a live oak tree, one limb of which passes through the bedroom and out through the roof." It was going to be in Sunset magazine. Otherwise, one supposes, it wouldn't have raised so much as an eyebrow. Although they might not have the same level of integration as the tree-in-the-bedroom scenario, you

needn't travel back 74 years to find arboreally friendly places.

Carmel Realty's got at least two on the market. Shelly Mitchell Lynch has a classic cottage on Dolores Street, and Zach Brooksher has a newly built home on Casanova near Ocean Avenue. One house hugs its trees, while the other is very nearly hugged by them.

Giant's window box

The latter property — designed Carmel architect Thomas Bateman Hood and constructed by Wayfinder Development — has four bedrooms and four-and-one-half baths for a total of more than 2,700 square feet of living space, including a guest house. It's listed for \$10.9 million.

The contemporary styling has an obvious Craftsman flavor, and floor-to-ceiling windows emphasize the strong connection to nature characteristic of that movement. Of

course, the three-story-plus oak that reaches through a custom-made opening in the deck doesn't hurt, either, and a large tree out front looks almost as if it's growing out of a giant's window box.

Anyone cooking in the stainless-steel outdoor kitchen might be tempted to toss a dish towel over a sturdy branch that protrudes into the space, then slopes dramatically upward, easily clearing the sink — and the chef's head.

The theme of welcoming and highlighting the outdoors continues with skylights, as well as light wood floors and ceilings. The primary bedroom overlooks gracefully arching oak branches, and exterior stone elements and accents complement the natural landscaping. A fire pit and conversation area visually connects the guest unit with the main house.

already believe and dismiss what makes us uncomfortable.

We can FaceTime anyone, anywhere but can't seem to talk to the person sitting across from us.

The values I grew up with weren't quaint relics of sentimental nostalgia. They were the operating system of a society that mostly worked. When sacrifice was shared, cynicism didn't get as much oxygen. When duty was expected, entitlement got told to stand in the corner.

When respect was the default setting, dignity wasn't negotiable. Again, not perfect — far from it — but there was this understanding that we were caretakers of something worth protecting, worth handing down.

Breakfast and cats

What really gets me is that witnessing itself has lost its value. Everything's recorded now — your breakfast, your cat, your opinions on breakfasts and cats yet nothing seems remembered. Every moment documented, few actually experienced. My generation watched history happen in real time and felt it in our bones. Empty plates at dinner. Blue star banners in windows. We knew freedom wasn't free because we literally saw the receipts.

Here's the problem: I don't know how to pass this down. I can't tweet the weight of witness. I can't make a TikTok about sitting in a darkened room during an air

raid drill, listening to adults pretend they weren't worried. These aren't quirky throwback stories. They're the foundation of who I became, and I'm watching that foundation crumble while everyone is busy looking at their screens.

Maybe Bush got it. Calling for a "kindler, gentler nation" wasn't wimpy — it was an SOS from someone who saw what we'd already lost and what we were zooming toward losing next. He understood that strength without kindness is criminal, and power without honor is just being a mob boss with a PR flak running interference

The thing keeping me up at night (besides my prostate) is whether anyone will care about any of this once I'm gone. Will the ground I trod mean anything, or will it just get paved over for another parking lot? Probably a parking lot, especially in Carmel where more parking is needed.

But I keep writing about it anyway. Not because I'm confident anyone's listening - I've seen people walk into fountains while texting, so that ship has sailed — but because some things are worth saying even into the void. Most days it feels like trying to bail out the Titanic with a teaspoon. But it's my teaspoon, and I'll keep bailing until I physically can't. Because the alternative watching it all disappear without even a footnote — is somehow worse.

So yeah, even though I'm one of the last to remember all this, I'm trying not to be an old curmudgeon about it.

And by the way, stay the heck off my

CARMEL VALLEY HOME SETS THE PERFECT STAGE FOR ACT II

ARY AND Brenda Berke, having raised their family in a spacious bi-level San Francisco Bay area home, sensed the echoes among rooms once filled by children and decided it was time to downsize. For 20 years, they had lived in a 2,700-square-foot home on a 5,000-square-foot lot — which was not only abuzz with happy children, it was in close proximity to their neighbors.

"We wanted a place that was close to our San Francisco area families, but not quite so near our neighbors," said Brenda. "We looked at homes in Pebble Beach, Pacific Grove, Carmel and Monterey – we truly did our due diligence."

Ultimately, the Berkes found the property that "checked all the boxes" in Carmel Valley.

"After looking at so many properties that had nice amenities but weren't quite it, we saw an ad for an open house

in the valley and arrived 10 minutes early," said Gary. "This was exactly what we wanted — a turnkey house with no major adjustments or repairs required."

Dramatic light

Built in 1947, the 2,000-square-foot three-bedroom, three-bath house, with its wide-plank exterior siding and shingled roof, offered a country-meets-modern farmhouse aesthetic, which immediately appealed to the Berkes.

A path of wide steps sweeps through the front garden and up to a covered porch, where welcoming windchimes hang at the entrance. A whitewashed bench bears a housewarming gift: a large wooden plaque which reads, "Remember, as far as anyone knows, we're a nice,

normal family."

The front door of the Berke home leads directly into the

living room, a large, rectangular space beneath a wide-plank, A-frame ceiling supported by dramatic trusses and triangular wooden frameworks, punctuated by large domed wicker light fixtures. Natural light comes through a large picture window with sidelights, framing the natural valley landscape. While the house has air conditioning, the Berkes tend to prefer the breeze moving through the space via open front and back doors.

Beyond the living room is a large galley kitchen flanked by white cabinetry. A double farm sink rests beneath a trio of wide windows that let in light and valley views, and on the opposite wall, there's a stainless steel six-burner KitchenAid stove over double-wide oven, under a large stainless hood. Granite countertops add color and texture, as do a variety of cookbooks

and ceramic objets d'art.

The kitchen opens to a spacious dining room, which houses a glass table below a dramatic light fixture of large pendulous globes. A wall of glass offers a full view of the backyard, where an expansive patio, surfaced in a basketweave of ochre bricks, creates a sense of indoor-outdoor living.

Pizza's ready

The patio features a large horno - a beehive-shaped adobe pizza oven – plus a large gazebo sheltering a teak dining table and chairs, and a curved rattan couch next to a cement fire bowl. The patio is framed by a wide-spaced grape-stake fence trimmed in a strand of small globes to light the night — as is the edge of the roof.

The space was quite obviously designed with hospital-

Over on Dolores near 10th Street, a two-bedroom, twobath cottage with 1,600 square feet of living space is listed for \$3.5 million. The sellers, Steve Egan and Andrea Hoch, bought it a while back as a second home. In a familiar story, they liked it so much they wanted to move here full time, necessitating a search for a larger dwelling.

Said Egan and Hoch of their pied-à-terre, "We decided to embrace the tree. The name came from our brotherin-law — it is a play on the legal profession as both of us had careers in the law."

What name? Why, "Pardon Our Tree," of course.

The longtime occupant in question is a soaring pine that rises through a custom opening on a deck that's surrounded on three sides by the cottage, near the dining area. It's one of three trees involved in the structure. The other two are incorporated via openings carved into a larger rear deck, accessible from either bedroom.

The kitchen skylight picks up on the nature theme with floral stained glass. The living room has a fireplace

and there's Carmel stone on the front porch (a nice place to sit and contemplate the nearly nonexistent traffic) and patio area. There's also a roomy garage.

These are, of course, hardly the only properties $which \, accommodate \, and \, work \, with \, oaks, \, pines \, and \,$ others. A cursory cruise through the local real estate listings can help you spot several, from Carmel Valley, to the Peninsula and, of course, Big Sur.

Just like human roommates, some trees drop things – needles, leaves – that need to be swept up. And, just like roomies, they can become best friends, absorbing the secrets and dreams of the other occupants.

Dogs or trees?

Sometimes they can jangle nerves with latenight noises, and they have the most interesting guests, like wacky squirrels behaving like kids who broke into Mom's chardonnay, or owls hooting gently at dawn and dusk.

They have the right-of-way on streets, they're part of history — author Mary Austin reportedly did some writing in a treehouse — and even when they're being a little troublesome, Carmelites know they're expected to put up

with them like they're friendly house guests who refuse to leave.

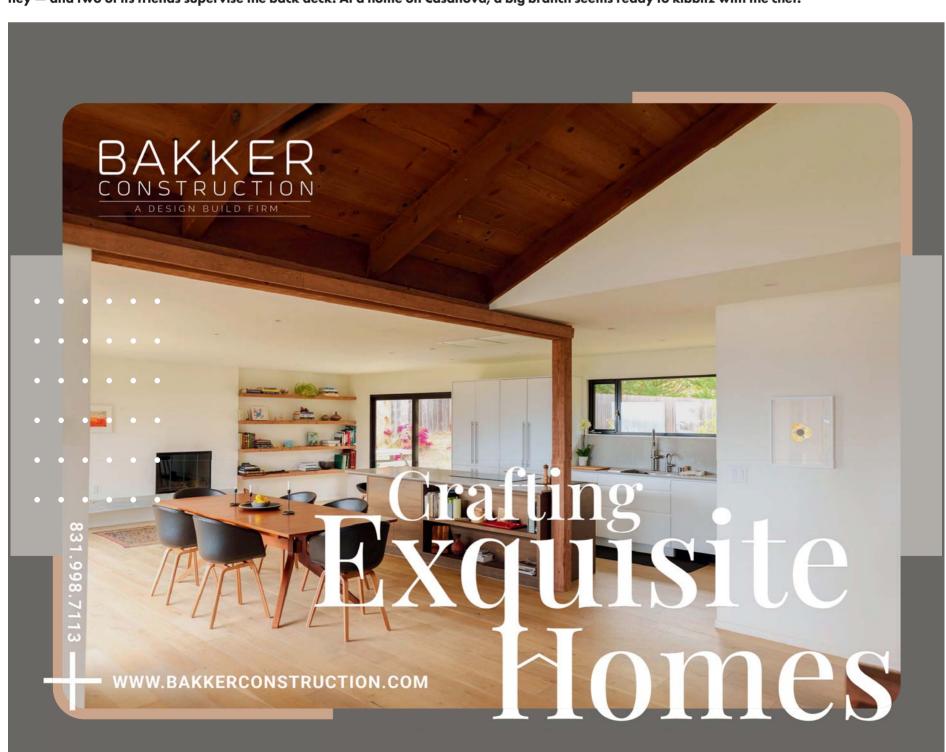
Mostly, though, they're pretty nice to have around and they are part of the local charm, perhaps competing only with canines for locals' love and attention.

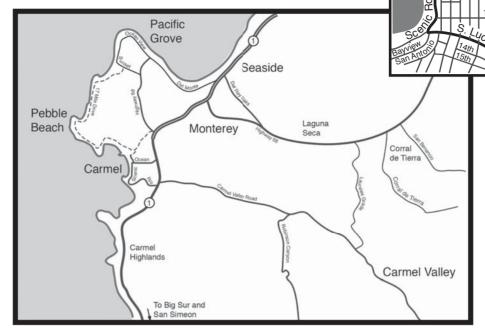

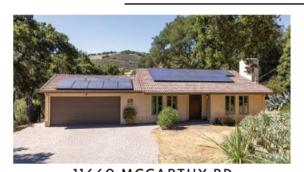

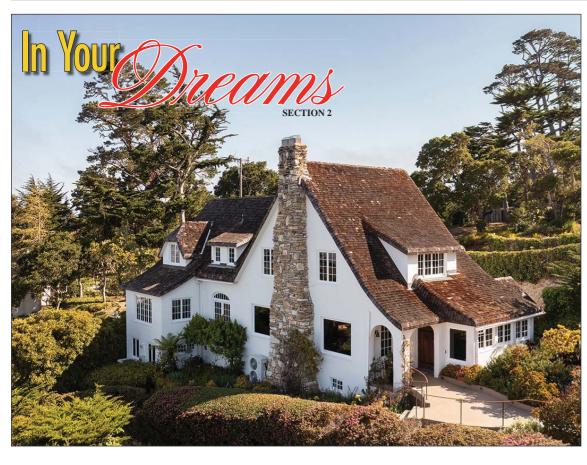

HIGHLANDS FAMILY READY TO TURN PAGE ON STORIED HOME

THE CHARMING cottage at 110 Pine Way is the 100-year-old grand dame of the Carmel Highlands. She remains a social fixture through no apparent effort, profiled last month in The Wall Street Journal as "House of the Week." Her esteemed position on a knoll directly above the Tickle Pink Inn is part of the allure. But mainly she's known for her first-rate pedigree and irresistible charm, both enhanced by the fact that the current owner spent nearly 30 years living there. High

above the Pacific in their four-bedroom home, Beth Neidel and her late husband, John, were constants in a sea of hotel guests and vacationers flocking to the Highlands.

Irreplaceable details

As custodians of their 1925 Tudor Revival, they happily exerted themselves to preserve irreplaceable details like hand-shaped wooden shingles, midcentury floral wallpaper, and a navy blue-enameled AGA stove, a British icon on its own merits

The Neidels' few personal additions are mere embel-

lishments on the origin story of 110 Pine Way. She's an M.J. Murphy house, which means something to anyone interested in Carmel's architectural history.

His heyday was more than a century ago, but Murphy's fingerprints remain all over town. Beginning in 1902, he enjoyed 40 years of success as a local contractor, the first call for residents, city officials and business owners, many wanting their structures in his signature "storybook" style. He's thought to be responsible for more than

 $300\ projects$ in the Carmel area. One of his most famous, the Highlands Inn, is just down the street, but few are as well-preserved as this 1925 home.

Ashley Wayland, whose namesake agency serves clients in all aspects of brokerage and property management, confidently introduced the home as an "architectural treasure," knowing the lengths to which the Neidels went to preserve the authenticity of Murphy's design and materials.

They paid \$450,000 for the 11,063 square-foot property in 1986. Their daughter, Linnah, told the Wall Street Journal she estimated that they spent about as much restoring and enhancing it. The home, now valued at more than 10 times that amount, is listed at \$4,775,000.

Past the detached garage, a discreet garden path opens to a scene Beatrix Potter would have killed to illustrate. It's a seascape, then a rambling garden, then fairytale pitched gables sloping from two stories overhead to soft curling edges above the main entrance. Nor can you overlook the Carmel stone chimney, which could belong on Robinson Jeffers' Tor House, another Murphy project located at Carmel Point.

Hand-shaped shingles

Wayland noted the original shingling was restored mostly on site, when Scudder Roofing brought its "guild" of craftsmen to steam-fit and shape each one. Details like these make the house potentially eligible for historic recognition under the Mills Act, which comes with a not-in-significant tax break.

The front door opens to a sunroom bathed in light and with a feeling not unlike a Victorian conservatory. Bouquets adorn the adjacent powder room — one vari-

ety of the (immaculate) wallpapers that add retro charm throughout.

The living area is immediately to the left. The swelling cove and mist-laden cypresses south of Point Lobos are visible through a pair of picture windows separated by a wood-burning fireplace, one of two in the home. Opposite are three archways, the large central one framing the greenery of a private interior courtyard. The room is low-ceilinged with heavy beams, walled with softly "brushed" board and batten — raised planks that add dimension and geometric interest. It's the obvious heart of the home, socially and creatively. Pianists might consider asking Ms. Neidel for tips on getting their baby grand up the narrow garden path.

The dining area, meanwhile, is a gust of fresh air. French doors feature at both ends, one set leading to the garden patio and the other for throwing open to the wild

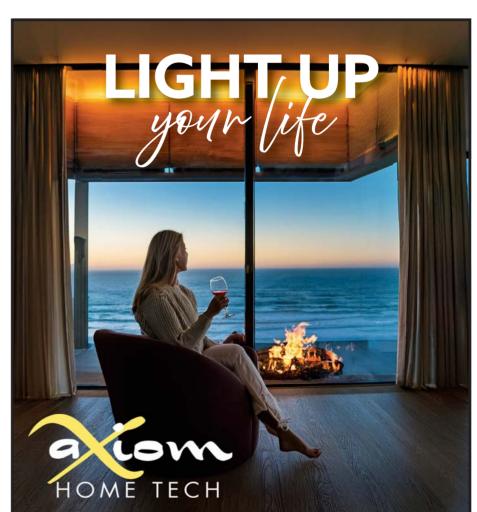

ocean, perhaps to cool things off when the dinner party conversation gets heated. Wall-to-wall ivory carpet adds to the effect, but Wayland said there's a well-preserved wooden floor underneath, at the very least downstairs and possibly upstairs, as revealed by a few uncarpeted closets.

Speaking of, some serious thought was put into storage throughout the 3,170-square-foot home, not least because there's a spacious basement. In 1904, Murphy founded what remains one of the best local hardware and building supply stores around, and he clearly prized function as well as beauty. Good bones and build aside, look for several cheeky details about. Secret rooms include an upstairs loft accessible through a Peter Rabbit-sized door, as well as a private reading room in the basement – if you can call it that, considering the ocean views.

The Neidels decided to add a few secrets of their own, one of which is left wide open in the dining area during tours: a hidden passageway behind the floor-to-ceiling bookcase, which swings open to reveal the first of four bedrooms. That's the downstairs primary, with sea-facing latched windows and an en suite bathroom.

Enjoying all three

It would be a straight shot down the hallway, past a cozy guest bed-and-bath to the kitchen — we're saving that for last, as Wayland suggested – except for the elevator. It was a late-in-life addition by the Neidels and will be a treat for future residents determined to enjoy all three floors of the home into their golden years.

Take it up to the second floor, where the family bedrooms number two. There's no question which is the primary, since it's directly above the living room and nearly the same size. Fronting the king bed are original casement windows and a second fireplace, with room enough for a few overstuffed chairs and a tea table. A reading nook between his-and-hers closets could easily fit a small lounge.

Across the hall, the view from a gabled twin bedroom

suite bathroom, as do the other three. All rely on modern amenities, including a tankless water heater and purifier, central heating and air conditioning, just for kicks.

Before heading back downstairs, be sure to check the closets. Not for nymphs and elves, but because the one opposite the staircase hides the tiny hatch to the aforementioned loft. It would make a lovely playroom or writing room, with steeply pitched ceilings and an outdoor staircase — that door is adult-sized — which descends to the private courtyard.

Consider it the scenic route to the kitchen, which is downstairs.

It's an experience — a 1970s vision of cornflower blue backsplashes and formica countertops. If it's not your thing, don't let the surface detract from the layout, ideal for home cooks serious about entertaining. There's a proper galley and a butler's pantry, two deep sinks, abundant storage for dishes and provisions, and easy access to the rock-walled garden patio.

Then, of course, there's the showstopping AGA range.

Though invented by the Nobel-awarded Swedish physicist Gustaf Dalen, production moved to the U.K. in the 1950s. Any chef between here and the Continent would tell you AGAs are highly coveted for their "always-on" temperature regulation, crucial to baking and roasting.

Reading and laundry

A tour of 110 Pine Way wouldn't be complete without a brief promenade through the serpentine gardens, arranged English-style but with native Californian flora and hardy succulents.

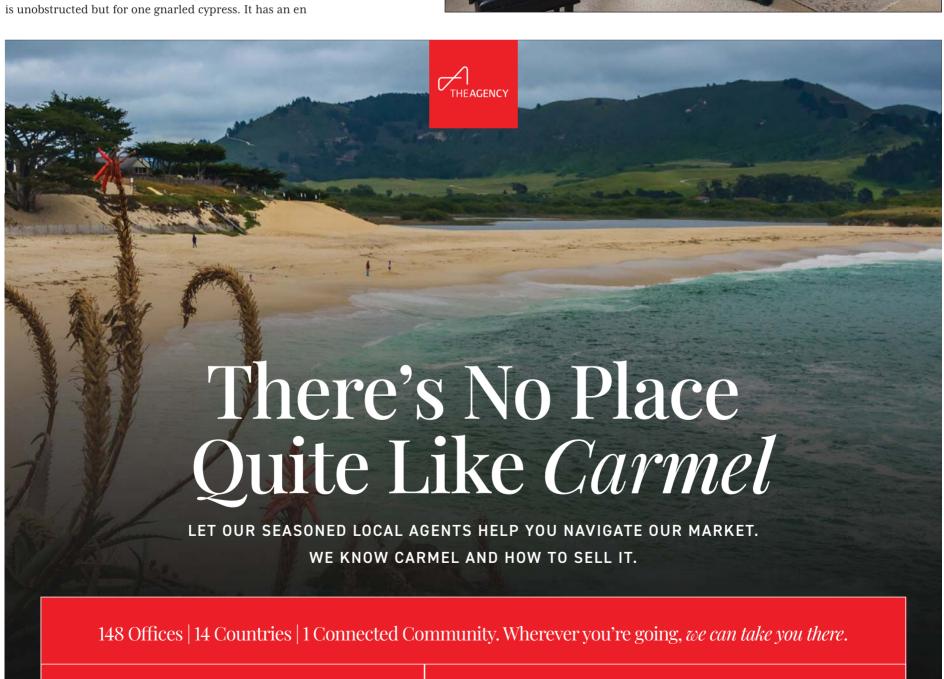
A path against the north side of the house leads to the basement, also accessible via elevator, which includes the aforementioned reading room, laundry area, and open storage space, which the Neidels converted to a home

Also on the north side of the garden, see if you can spot the path that the Neidels used as a shortcut to the Highlands Inn for breakfast or entertainment in the evening — because even perfect fairytales need an escape route.

There are four bedrooms to choose from, but who could blame a house guest for curling up and dozing off on this living room couch?

of shoes provided to investigators by his then-girlfriend was determined to have left shoe impressions in the backyard of the restaurant, near the door where the killer made entry. He was considered a suspect in the initial investigation, though no charges were filed at that time.

The Monterey County Sheriff's Office diligently pursued the case for decades and continued to submit and re-submit items of evidence in the case for newer and more sophisticated DNA testing.

In 2024 and 2025, additional DNA testing provided very strong support that Bastian was a contributor to DNA mixtures on the inside of the shoes provided to investigators by his girlfriend, the handle of the knife, and the nightshirt worn by Eva Thompson that was collected at her autopsy.

The Hon. Andrew G. Liu presided over the 10-day jury

trial. Bastian faces a prison sentence of life without the possibility of parole.

In July 2020, District Attorney Jeannine M. Pacioni created the Monterey County District Attorney's Office Cold Case Task Force, which represents the largest and most comprehensive countywide effort to investigate, solve and prosecute cold-case homicides in Monterey County.

Since the creation of the Cold Case Task Force, six defendants have been convicted of seven cold-case murders at jury trial, two defendants have pleaded guilty to cold-case murders, four additional defendants are awaiting trial for murder, and one suspect is pending trial for a cold-case sexual assault. Three other homicides were closed due to the death or mental incompetency of the identified suspect. Ten previously unidentified decedents have also been identified through DNA

In January 2022, the Monterey County District Attorney's Office Cold Case Task Force received a \$535,000 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice. The grant provides funding to support forensic testing and investigative activities in the prosecution of cold cases where DNA from a suspect has been identified.

The case was originally investigated by numerous retired deputies, investigators, forensic evidence technicians, and other staff from the Monterey County Sheriff's Office.

The most recent team to reopen the case included district attorney investigators Oliver Minnig, Justin Bell, Pete Ramirez and Dominique Hohmann, sheriff's detective Sgt. Mike Smith (retired), and sheriff's management analyst Ben Fowler. Criminalists and retired criminalists with the California Department of Justice, Bureau of Forensic Services Crime Laboratories in Watsonville, Richmond and Riverside provided valuable analysis and testimony, along with the Serological Research Institute in Richmond.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Spokane Police Department and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department also assisted with obtaining DNA samples from out-ofstate witnesses.

Aug. 28 — A jury convicted Victor Ramirez, 46, of three counts of lewd or lascivious acts on a child under the age of 14 in violation of California Penal Code section 288(a). All three Penal Code section 288(a) offenses are serious and violent felonies and are considered strikes under California's three strikes law.

Ramirez will also be required to register as a sex offender. At sentencing, Ramirez faces up to 12 years in state prison.

On April 25, 2021, at approximately 3 a.m., Monterey County Sheriff Deputy Juan Anguiano and Commander Nicole Davis responded to a report of a sexual battery on a 10-year-old child, Jane Doe.

Commander Davis spoke with Doe at the scene who told

ity in mind.

Yet the primary feature on the patio is an elderly oak, its branches wrapped in strands of lights and reaching across the yard – which, said Brenda Berke, was one reason to purchase the property.

Framed by foliage

Below the main patio is a second, circular one, framed by foliage and fencing, which formed a perfect venue for their son's wedding last year.

Beyond the property, which is set up to accommodate an active-outdoor life-

style - bocce ball, basketball, cornhole spreads the verdant foliage of Carmel Valley, with its live oaks, scrubs and pines. A stand of sentinel cypresses extends as far as the eye can see, to the dramatic palisades rising in the distance.

Neighboring homes are barely visible in the landscape – present, but nuanced by nature.

her Ramirez, a family friend, had touched her on her thighs and private part as well as exposed his penis to her in the living room of his home after a party he was hosting had

Det. Daivd Gonzalez was assigned for further follow up on the case. A forensic interview with Doe was conducted where she was consistent with her allegations against Ramirez.

In addition to Monterey County Sheriff Deputy Juan Anguiano, Cmndr. Nicole Davis, and Det. David Gonzalez, the prosecution was assisted by district attorney investigators Daisy Gurley and Rachel Maldonado. Jane Doe was assisted by the district attorney's office victim witness advocates Mayra Sanchez and Kristin Peterson.

Court facility support dog Armani provided Doe with much needed support during her testimony at trial.

Aug. 29 — Judge Jennifer J. O'Keefe sentenced Julio Martinez, 43 and a resident of Greenfield, to 18 years in prison for committing two counts of lewd acts upon a child under 14 years of age, and two counts of assault with intent to commit a lewd act upon a child under 14 years of.

These offenses are all serious and violent felonies and are considered strikes under California's three strikes law. Martinez will also be required to register as a sex offender for the rest of his life.

Jane Doe 1 reported that Martinez, a family member, had touched her thigh over the clothes on one occasion while she was sleep-

Jane Doe 2 reported that Maritnez had molested her on two separate occasions. Both victims delayed reporting the crimes for over a year because they had a close relationship with Martinez.

According to research into sexual assault victim behavior, it is very common for victims to delay reporting the sexual abuse, especially when the victim is a minor and has a close relationship with the perpetrator.

This case was investigated by Greenfield Police Det. Armando Lerma as well as other Greenfield police officers. The victim in this case was assisted by district attorney's office victim witness program manager Alma Sanchez.

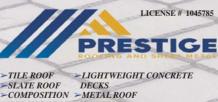

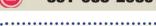

happen. (Assuming the chef is amenable.) There are two separate sinks, one of which is of the nice, deep farmhouse variety.

Appliances — including two dishwashers and refrigerators — are artfully concealed behind thick wooden cabinetry. A stone arch frames the professional range and works well with the rustic stone floor.

Vaulted ceilings

A second, smaller wet bar is concealed behind an adjacent wall — the better to keep people out from underfoot while they refill their cocktails — and you can walk directly onto the ocean-facing patio, which is outfitted with an al fresco kitchen and wood-burning fireplace.

Two half-baths are available on the main floor, plus one on the lower level, where there's a sitting room and a charming stone wine cellar with space for more than 500 bottles and room for a few people to sit down and contemplate bouquets and vintages.

Storage areas, utilities and a laundry room round out the lower floor.

The second floor has four bedrooms with en suite baths. Wallpaper and matching drapes are used to great effect in one bedroom, complementing the vaulted open-beam ceilings and continuing the European feeling.

The bedroom in the primary suite, with

its own fireplace, takes center stage directly above the living room, with the same glorious views. It's surrounded by two full spa-like bathrooms, an office and a sitting room, as well as two walk-in closets. Although it dominates the floor, the three guest bedrooms aren't exactly dwarfed—they range in size from about 260 square feet to more than 350 square feet, not including the bathrooms or walk-in closets. Also, none of the bedrooms shares a wall with another.

Finally, there's a more contemporary guest apartment over the garage that might also work as a caretaker unit. It has a full kitchen, bedroom and bath, along with significant storage space.

The main house has an air purification system and radiant floor heat.

Speaking of the floors, they're hard-wood and stone throughout, and custom woodwork contributes to the home's timeless storybook feeling. An elevator serves all three levels of the house.

Take a walk

We'd be remiss if we didn't mention the grounds. The landscaping is formal, but not fussy, with bushy hydrangeas that have blooms bigger than a soccer ball, immaculate green turf, sculpted shrubbery and assorted native plants. That patio seems like a perfect place to watch the sunset with a glass of port, or enjoy a quiet morning with a cup of coffee. But if you don't feel like making your own, you could always stroll over the Lodge. It's what Siri would want.

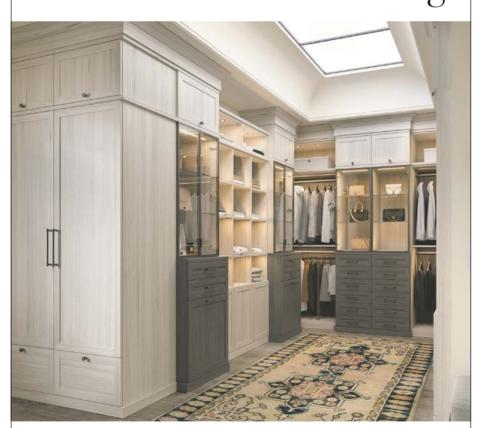

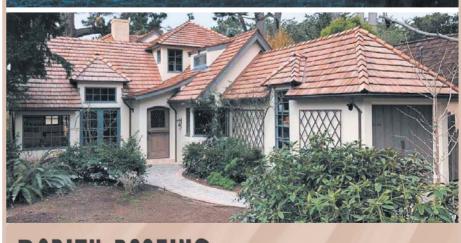
